Annual Report 2024

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About this report

This report is a summary of the activities of the Northern B Health and Disability Ethics Committee (HDEC) for the period of 01 July 2023 – 30 June 2024. It includes a summary of the applications reviewed during the year, details of any complaints received (and how they were resolved), and a list of new applications submitted.

About the committee

The Northern B Health and Disability Ethics Committees (HDEC) is a Ministerial committee established under section 87 of the Pae Ora (Healthy Futures) Act 2022). Its members are appointed by the Minister of Health through the public appointments process.

The primary function of the Committee is to provide independent ethical review of health research and innovative practice in order to safeguard the rights, health and wellbeing of consumers and research participants and, in particular, those persons with diminished autonomy by checking that it meets or exceeds established ethical standards.

Approvals and registrations

The Northern B HDEC is approved by the Health Research Council Ethics Committee for the purposes of section 25(1)(c) of the <u>Health Research Council Act 1990</u>.

The Northern B HDEC is registered (number IRB00008715) with the United States' Office for Human Research Protections. This registration enables the committee to review research conducted or supported by the US Department of Health and Human Services.

Chairperson's report

It is my privilege to present this Annual Report of the work of Northern B HDEC (NTB) over the last year.

NTB has operated effectively over the reporting period, and in accordance with the HRCEC's expectations of efficient processes and fit-for-purpose ethical review. An appointment round is planned for the remaining months of 2024 and full membership will continue. Historically, it has been difficult to recruit non-lay members with a medical background, but with the expertise shared across the four HDECs any gaps have been overcome. I am so thankful for the dedication and expertise of Dr Devonie Waaka (seconded from Southern HDEC) who joins me on the review of expedited applications, amendments, and protocol deviations.

The long-awaited Sector Day held in December 2023 was a highlight, and after years of Zoom-only interactions, the opportunity to be together face to face was exceptionally valuable. It was particularly rewarding to meet new members in person, and to farewell our long serving Manager Nic Aagaard.

Another highlight has been the opening of channels for communication for the HDEC Chairs on an asneeded basis with SCOTT and GTAC. It is important that peer and ethical review of proposals work in harmony. Likewise, Locality Authorisation (including Consultation) is an essential element of the country's suite of protections, and with the changes to the national health authority there may be an opportunity to consolidate Locality Authorisation processes for research to retain district interests in a streamlined or coordinated way. This may be helpful for clinical trials to open more sites across the country, reducing the administrative burden and time costs for Investigative teams who additionally carry a high clinical load.

The Advisors of the Secretariat continue to exhibit very high levels of professionalism and expertise even in the disruptive and uncertain context of a change of Government. Their workload is heavy, yet the weekly HDECs meetings invariably operate smoothly. It is critical that the resources for all the committees supported by the Secretariat do not fall to unsustainable levels, and that the focus remains squarely on matters that fall within HDECs Scope of Review. This, of course, has consequences for the IECs and their institutions who must continue to support and educate health researchers whose inquiry falls outside our scope whilst ensuring sound governance and management for studies which do have an HDEC approval. Variability between the universities and other research institutions with respect to their roles and obligations as study Sponsors is still apparent.

The members of NTB continue to hold research accountable to the National Ethical Standards, most especially with respect to voluntary and informed consent. Complex and overly long Information Sheets are invariably called out as such, and participant friendly alternatives – such as diagrams, tables or flowcharts – suggested. We insist that the research elements are distinguished from Standard of Care (in New Zealand), the risks are accurately described, and the benefits of participation are not overstated or ambiguous. This latter includes not naming an investigational or experimental product as "treatment". A revised plain language template Information Sheet and Consent Form will be available in the latter part of 2024, and it is hoped that this will overcome some of the challenges to informed consent presented by difficult and technical language.

While anticipated, a surge in volume of applications involving AI or algorithm development has not yet eventuated for HDECs. Although much of this work is likely falling outside HDECs Scope (as a secondary use of identifiable health data with or without consent) it is important that this kind of activity complies with the required ethical and data standards. It is uncertain whether it is all being captured within existing review structures nationally.

Finally, I wish to express my gratitude to the sponsors, researchers and coordinators who continue to strive for scientific integrity and good ethical conduct, and for knowledge which can improve the health and wellbeing of all New Zealanders. Their willingness to attend NTB meetings, respectfully engage in ethical discourse and respond to the Committee's requirements reflects well on New Zealand as a great place to do research. I look forward to the coming year.

Complaints and overdue application summary

This section outlines complaints about decisions made by the Committee during 2024.

Complaints received

Complaint one

Type of complaint: Study Conduct

Date resolved: 05 July 2023

Complaint received: 01 July 2023

Nature of complaint:

A participant attempted to contact study coordinators via multiple methods and received no response for almost a month or auto-replies directing to emails that did not work.

Actions taken:

The Secretariat investigated whether the information provided to participants was up to date and contacted the study team. Response was received by Sponsor that this was a one-off incident, and points of contact will be monitored more closely. Their responses were still not timely to the participant, and the CI and study contact were reminded again to ensure all contact information is correct and to ensure responsiveness to participants.

Outcome:

The Secretariat received no further contact indicating the participant was experiencing delays.

Complaint two

Type of complaint: Study Conduct Date resolved: 26 January 2024

Complaint received: 01 December 2023

Nature of complaint:

A person went to a clinical trials unit and was made to feel uncomfortable. During the pre-screening, they allege misconduct by the nurse and that they were pressured into remaining, including forced back onto the bed and had their ID taken from them. They note they had participated in multiple trials at this trials unit before and that this was an exceptional circumstance.

Actions taken:

The Secretariat with permission contacted the trial unit to discuss the matter.

Outcome:

The complainant had contacted the unit before contacting us, and received an apology and acknowledgement of the incident before the complainant contacted the HDECs. The site provided details outlining the steps that were taken to address the complaint so it would not happen again. The Chair considered the actions satisfactory to address the complaint. The complainant was advised to contact the HDC if they feel they want to lodge a further complaint.

Overdue review

Average review times take into account the time taken for the Secretariat to process applications and the time taken for the Committee to review applications. The clock is stopped when a decision letter is emailed to applicants. Average review times exclude time taken for researchers to respond to requests for further information. Researchers have up to 90 days to respond.

Average review time was 17 days for expedited applications. Target timeframe for expedited applications is 15 calendar days (<u>Standard Operating Procedures for Health and Disability Ethics Committees</u>, para 9-102). The reason for the slight deviation outside expectation was due to Secretariat delays in process the letters following review by the sub-committee.

Average review time was 29 days for full applications. Target timeframe for full applications is 35 days (<u>Standard Operating Procedures for Health and Disability Ethics Committees</u>, para 54-59). There were no notable exceptions outside of the target timeframe for the reporting period.
